CONSISTORY MINUTES

Discussion on article "Being the Church in a Post-Christian Culture" by Michael Craven.

REGULAR BUSINESS

Approved the August 14, 2025 minutes- MMSC (Bob/Alex) Approved the August 14, 2025 financials-MMSC (Knut/Mark) August giving and attendance analysis by Alex Johnson.

Around the room check-in with each consistory members and pastors. Gary Zeutenhorst closed in prayer.

TEAM REPORTS (Purposeful Learning) Dean/Knut, Dean reported that he had talked to Julia and she is still looking for teachers and substitute teachers. He indicated that Jay has some concerns about the costs associated with Rocky Mountain High. Jay stated he is planning on taking the Sr High youth group to Rocky. Jay is also looking for some individuals to fill youth sponsor positions (Holy Living) Gary/Ryan, Women's ministry will be meeting 10/08 to plan a Christmas Tea in December. They attended the "David" movie in Emmetsburg but only 9 people attended. Terry Stevens scheduled a meeting between services 9/21 to address ways in which greeters and ushers can be more focused regarding getting new members and visitors more engaged in the church. They will be getting lanyards which are for those who are greeting and ushering and for staff. Men's ministry has continued meeting and hoping to get numbers back up once the Spencer Fair is over. Library committee planning an open house 9/21 in between services. (Loving Outreach) Bob/Alex, Bob stated that the Missions team had not met this month. The Prayer and Praise met for the first time on Tuesday at its regular time. The Feed the Children program did meet Wednesday night. (Passionate Worship) Kevin/Jason. Ryan has scheduled 4 different worship teams for the month of October. Those teams will continue to sing together going forward. Ryan also is asking for volunteers to help break down and take equipment back after the service in the backyard at the Runcorn's on the 28th. (Meaningful Fellowship) Doug/Kelly, Doug stated that Marilyn Winterboer is stepping down from her position coordinating the greeter volunteers. Kris Toay is also stepping down from her position coordinating the usher volunteers as well. They will be needing to fill those positions. Security team continues to be working well. (Wholehearted Service) Mark/Kevin, Mark stated that Jill had attended her first Bible Study Fellowship. Her time will be put under professional development. Kevin stated they will be getting some other bids for the new sign out front. Need to be aware of city and DOT regulations in planning for the construction of the sign.

PASTOR'S REPORT

James will be starting with the book of Numbers in the "Cover to Cover" series. James stated he has been doing personnel reviews with staff and this has been going well. James indicated that he needs to have his review scheduled and discussed who would be involved. Previously it had been Jay and VP of consistory. This is the amount needed after the rebate program was utilized. Discussion about tree removal, grading grass where trees have been removed, seeding, and concrete needs.
