

1.9 million people are serving time behind bars in the United States. 95% will ultimately be released. 2 out of 3 of those released will be rearrested. Too often, formerly incarcerated people return to prison because they lack encouragement, mature faith, and a supportive church family.

Crossroads Prison Ministries help men and women rebuild their lives on a foundation of faith so they leave prison as new people, ready to serve their families and communities. This is done by connecting people behind bars with mentors on the outside to study God's Word together through the mail. Life-changing Bible studies have been developed. These completed lessons are sent to a volunteer mentor who reads through the lesson and reviews it. The mentors help students to better understand God's Word and to apply it to their lives. An encouraging letter is sent with the lesson when it is sent back to the prisoner. These may be the only message of hope and love they receive.

How can you help?

- **Become a mentor** to bring hope and life to those behind prison walls.
- **Give financially.** Hope Church does support this ministry so that there is no cost to the students. You can support this ministry as well.
- **Prayer powerful.** Pray that God will continue to change lives, prisons, churches, and entire communities through the ministry of Crossroads.

TEAM REPORTS

Purposeful Learning Dean/Knut, Dean stated that Julia has the children memorizing scripture and has ways to include the congregation in having the kids recite their verses to members of the congregation. Julia also is talking about raising money to buy a donkey for a person in Haiti. Jay reported a very successful Youth Auction bringing in \$38,210. I had the middle school lock-in and that went well. Had a youth leadership retreat last month and planned a Senior High lock-in 11/22.

Holy Living Gary/Ryan, Gary reported that the Women's Ministry has a Christmas Tea scheduled for December 6th. They are in the process of gathering information by surveying the women of Hope for ideas for future activities. Library has sent in their computer to get it upgraded and is waiting to get this back. Ryan reported the Men's Ministry is planning a Turkey dinner on Saturday the 22nd from 11:00 to 1:00. This is a fund raiser for the Men's Ministry to fund future activities and not have to rely on church funds if possible.

Wholehearted Service Mark/Kevin G, Mark reported that Jill indicated the new phones have been installed and they will be getting some new updates in January. Kristy indicated that they could use more volunteers for funerals.

Loving Outreach Bob/Alex, Alex reported that Hope is responsible for Meals on Wheels for the month of December. Still need to have people sign up for this. Discussed that there are three mission funds, one designated for Haiti and two other funds undesignated. MMSC to change the Haiti fund to Mission Trip Fund. MMSC to combine all three Mission Funds into one fund "Mission Trip Fund" (Alex/Jason). People who are planning on going on the Eswatini trip are holding a fundraiser meal in the Harbor on from 11:00-1:00 on the Sunday the 16th to raise money for the mission trip.

Passionate Worship Kevin/Jason, Kevin reported that Ryan has started to plan for December and Christmas Eve service. Eric stated they have 2 coats of paint on the front stage. The rest of the stage extension will be done end of the week. Carpet will be put in next which will be all the same across the stage. December 2nd the company that we bought the video screens will be coming to help install the screens.

Meaningful Fellowship Doug/Kelly, Doug stated that Steve and Kim Rhode have volunteered to take over the role of coordinating greeters and ushers. One of the issues discussed was to incorporate more of an emphasis on intentional focus on 1st time visitors and get them more connected.

PASTORS REPORT

James will respond to some of those and do short sermonette and then give time to reflect and then do another set of questions. James stated that he has initially posted the worship leader position posted to Ozark Christian College, Grand Canyon University, Northwestern and the church website.
